HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.153

Reps. Berman, LaFave, Markkanen, Reilly, Maddock, Ellison, Mueller, Allor, Chirkun, Garza, Lasinski, Love and Warren offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare September 11-17, 2019, as Patriot Week
- 2 in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, We recognize that understanding American history and
- 4 America's first principles are indispensable to the survival of our
- 5 republic as a free people. In great reverence to the victims of the
- ${f 6}$ attacks on September 11, 2001, we acknowledge that American
- 7 citizens must take time to honor the first principles, founders,
- 8 documents, and symbols of their history; and
- **9** Whereas, The events that led to the signing of *The*
- 10 Constitution of the United States of America by the delegates of
- 11 the Constitutional Convention on September 17, 1787, have

- 1 significance for every American. This historical occasion is
- 2 honored in public schools across the nation on September 17 of each
- 3 year as Constitution Day; and
- 4 Whereas, Revolution, the rule of law, social compact,
- 5 equality, unalienable rights, and limited government are the first
- 6 principles upon which America was founded and flourishes; and
- 7 Whereas, Exceptional, visionary, and indispensable Americans
- 8 such as Thomas Paine, Patrick Henry, John Adams, John Marshall,
- 9 George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Frederick Douglass, Martin
- 10 Luther King, Jr., Cesar Chavez, Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Susan B.
- 11 Anthony, Thomas Jefferson, and James Madison founded and advanced
- 12 the United States; and
- 13 Whereas, The Declaration of Independence, the Constitution and
- 14 the congressional resolution forwarding the Constitution to the
- 15 states, Marbury v Madison, Seneca Falls Declaration of Sentiments
- 16 and Resolutions, the Gettysburg Address, the Emancipation
- 17 Proclamation, Brown v Board of Education, the Civil Rights Act of
- 18 1964, and the "I Have a Dream" speech are key documents that embody
- 19 America's first principles and have advanced American liberty; and
- 20 Whereas, The Bennington Flag, the original Betsy Ross American
- 21 flag, the current American Flag, the Suffragist Flag, the Fort
- 22 Sumter Flag, the Gadsden Flag, and the flag of the state of
- 23 Michigan are fundamental physical symbols of American history and
- 24 freedom that should be studied and remembered by each American
- 25 citizen; now, therefore, be it
- 26 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 27 this legislative body declare September 11-17, 2019, as Patriot
- 28 Week in the state of Michigan. We recognize that each generation
- 29 needs to renew the spirit of America based on America's first

- 1 principles, historical figures, founding documents, and symbols of
- 2 America. The citizens, schools, and other educational institutions,
- 3 government agencies, municipalities, and nonprofit, religious,
- 4 labor, community, and business organizations are urged to recognize
- 5 and participate in Patriot Week by honoring and celebrating so that
- 6 all may offer the reverence that is due to our free republic.
